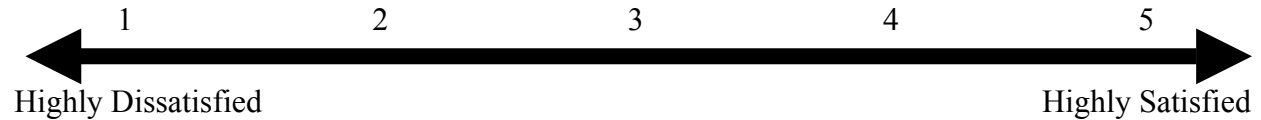


HOW WELL DOES YOUR SCHOOL SERVE EACH STUDENT?

Step 1: Write a “best guess response” to each of the questions below.

Step 2: After you write each response, rate your degree of satisfaction with the response using the 5-point scale below.



Question	Write your best guess response to each question below.	Degree of Satisfaction
1. How many of the students who enter your school in 9 th grade graduate in 4 years?		
2. What percentage of your graduates must take remedial courses in college or a community college? What percentage of those finish college?		
3. In what ways does your leadership team successfully interact with “hard-to-reach” parents?		
4. How many low-income and how many minority students are enrolled in advanced courses?		
5. How many teachers from different disciplines work together on a regular basis?		
6. Are the aspirations, strengths, and weaknesses of each student known by at least one faculty member or other member of your staff? How do you ensure the staff member uses that information appropriately to help the student become successful in all classes and activities?		
7. What percentage of the classes per week at your school are primarily lecture-driven?		
8. Aside from student government, in what ways do students have a voice on important issues at your school?		
9. How well were you able to support your responses to questions 1 thru 8 with data?		

Step 3: For each rating of 3 or below, consider what actions must be taken to make your satisfaction rating for that item a 5.

Step 4: Consider the implications for you and your colleagues if you believe that questions 1–8 are indicators of how well your school serves the needs of each student.
